


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Side Abutment to Parapet Wall

Breather membranes (Low Resistent) Must be counter battened as per requirements of BS 5250:2011, See BS 5534, S.R. 82:2017 for best code of practice

Notes and specifications.

1. Concrete coping on approved DPC
2. Metal cover flashing
3. Metal soaker interleaved with Slates
4. Cedral Thrutone Slates
5. Slating Battens
6. Counterbattens
7. Ventex Underlay carried up ends of battens
8. Truss/Rafter
9. Cavity wall

Note: Not less than 40mm clear distance to be maintained between rafter/truss and chimney walls.

Use Cedral double-blank slates in alternate courses to side abutment. Fix with 3 no. Tegral copper nails and 2 no. Tegral copper crampions.
